Club Championships Round 6

12 swimmers took part in round 6 of our Club Championships held at Saint Brigid's pool on Saturday July 14th. It was great to see a couple of new old faces when Jacqueline and Zita stepped up to the blocks (more on Zita later).

This round consisted of a 200m Choice and 25m Choice swim so there was something for both the stayers and the sprinters.

There was only one swim where maximum points were scored. Well done Graham Hicks for a speedy 25m breast stroke. Other swims of note were Jeff's 25m backstroke and Lexie's 25m breast stroke which scored them both 4 points.

One of the events that the crowd had come to see was the 200m shootout between Jeff and Chris. For those statistically minded Chris has always managed to touch the wall ahead of Jeff in this event but the gap has been closing over the years and on July 14th 2012 Jeff broke through with a win and what a win it was – almost the length of the pool. Well done Jeff but has the result of the drug test come back yet???

On a sad note Zita had to withdraw part way through her 200m swim due to injury. We hope she won't miss too many weeks and expect to see her back in the pool soon.

First time age group club records were set by Jacqueline (25 Free & 200 Breast), Kevin (25 Breast and 200 Free) and Stanley (25 & 200 Back). A four year old record held by Fettes (200m Back) was broken by Graham by over 35 seconds. Well done again Graham.

There has been some significant movement on the Leader Board after this round with Jeff having some breathing space at the top of the points table but Yvonne Hunt, Jannette, Lexie and Graham Hicks within striking distance.
