### CLUB ENDURANCE 1000 TROPHY

<b>By-Law: 3</b>	<b>Club Endurance 1000 Perpetual Trophy</b>

<b>Last Amended: 20/03/2017</b>	<b>Change to qualifying points</b>

1. Armadale Masters Swimming Club awards the Club Endurance 1000 (Aerobics) Perpetual Trophy to the first male and female club member who score the most points in the Endurance 1000 events in WA in accordance with sub-clauses below. In addition the winners receive a small trophy or prize in recognition of their achievements.
2. The second and third place club members in both male and female categories receive small trophy or prize in recognition of their achievements.
3. Endurance 1000 points are calculated using the Endurance 1000 program administrated by Masters Swimming Australia. The Endurance 1000 program runs from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December each year.

Endurance 1000 points can only be awarded to member's First Claim Club, therefore Second Claim members are ineligible for this trophy.

4. Armadale Masters Swimming Club totals the points gained in Endurance 1000 swims by each member using the Endurance 1000 program from the 1<sup>st</sup> January to a date nominated by the committee prior to the Awards Dinner.
5. Trophies are presented at the club's annual Awards Dinner in December.
6. After the presentation the perpetual trophy is returned to the Armadale Masters Trophy cabinet at Armadale Aquatic Centre for all to view.
