AMSC 2021 Club Championships Round 6 – 2021

Armadale Masters Swimming Club Club Championships Round 6, 2021 We had 14 swimmers and with just 2 lanes and 3 events we whipped through the program and finished well before 10am. There were several reported false starts and some unusual finishes but luckily for the swimmers involved I did not see them and so no DQ's on the days. Only a few stayed for the cool down whilst the others rushed off to get their bacon and eggs.

Points Scored: Sue was our top point's scorer on the day with 13 points followed by Liz and Graham on 11 points.

PB's: 2 PB's swum on the day by Pamela and Gillian. Pamela lowered her existing 50m breaststroke time by 2.25 seconds and Gillian again lowered her 100m butterfly record by 0.43 of a second. Club Records: It's been a good year for new club records and another 7 were lowered. The ladies in the club are on form at the moment and are lowering many existing club records and by some quite large margins. Time to step up gents. Sarah adding yet another 3 club records to her list – This time lowering the 100m butterfly in her age group by an incredible margin of 34 seconds, lowering the existing 50m breaststroke by 11.46 seconds and also lowering the 25m freestyle by more than 3.5 seconds. Nice one Sarah! Nicole swimming her first club championships in a long while, set a new club record in the 100m breaststroke by 2.7 seconds. Gillian still working on her butterfly lowered her existing record by 0.43 of a second. Adele set 2 new club records lowering the existing 100m freestyle by 2.5 seconds and the 25m backstroke by 1.3 seconds.
