

Masters Swimming WA State Championships

The 2025 WA state Championships were held on the first weekend of May. We had 3 swimmers compete Sarah, Megan and Nat.

The Armadale Masters Swimming Club with just three swimmers earned an impressive 164 points and securing 15th place overall.

Meg had an outstanding weekend, finishing second in the 45–49 age group. She swam personal bests in all six of her events, including a remarkable 18-second improvement in the 200m Butterfly. Meg also broke three club records in the 200m Butterfly, 100m Breaststroke, and 50m Freestyle. An incredible effort and well-deserved results!

Nat had a stellar meet, winning her age group 30–34 by just 2 points and achieving four personal bests. She also set four new club records in the 200m Freestyle, 100m Backstroke, 200m Backstroke, and 200m Individual Medley. Well done Nat!

Sarah rounded out the trio, finishing equal second behind ex Olympian Sally (Foster) Hunter in the 40-44 age group. Sally was "Female Swimmer of the Meet", very tough competition in 40-44 age group. She set a personal best in the 200m Freestyle, breaking her own club record in the process. Fantastic work, Sarah!
